

Amendments to NRSAA Angling Rules agreed at AGM 8/02/2014

(Amendments not incorporated with current set of rules yet. These amendments are effective as from 8 February 2014 .)

Rule No. 5

Measurement to Weight conversion tables allowed as published on the website; "Official NRSAA Length to Weight Conversion Tables rev01 17/02/2014"

Rule No. 5.1.1 (b)

All edible species conforming to Marine and Resources Act, will count towards a weight point (no minimum weight required) providing;

1. Correct measurement method applied to the species as required and indicated on the conversion tables.
2. Correct measurement method, length, was witness, confirmed by a witness, recorded and signed by a witness from other club or by weigh master.
3. Angers to convert measurement to weight point using latest version of the "Official NRSAA Length to Weight Conversion Tables"(as published on the NRSAA website), sign and hand to club representative.

Rule No.13.1.2

Powers of Captains Meeting

1. Angling times fixed at AGM (8/02/2014) for the angling year 2014.
 - a. Captains Meeting 07h00
 - b. Lines in 07h30
 - c. Lines up 15h30
2. Meeting to decide on angling area for the day.
3. Meeting to decide on final assembly point after lines up.
4. Receive Notices from NRSAA.
5. Power of the meeting is restricted to the above.

Rule No. 15.2

Edible fish competition points

1. Rule change to; 1 competition per kilogram (previously it was 2 points per kilogram)
 - a. No minimum weight for Cob, Galjoen, Blacktail, Steenbras
 - b. Foreign edible species like Shad, Garrick, and Mullet to weigh a minimum of 0.7kg.

Rule No. 15.3

Non-Edible fish competition points

2. Unchanged with a minimum weight of 2kg

Rule No. 15.4(c)

League points for “mombakkie” or no catch for the day to be 25% of the lowest league point for the day.

Junior Status was agreed on AGM to be changed from 18 years of age to 21 years of age. However, this decision must also be approved by NNSC and until approval received from the NNSC the status of the Juniors will stay unchanged at 18 years of age.

All other rules stay unchanged
